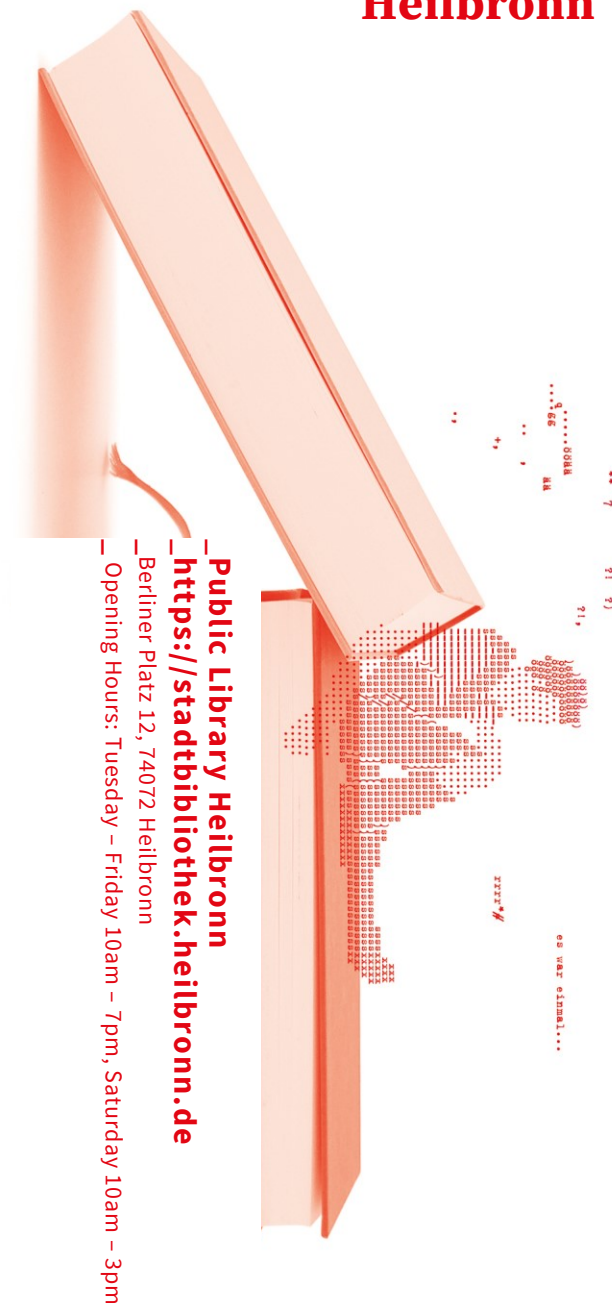

The media offered

There are also media on offer that are in different languages. E-books and other electronic media in the online-library can be downloaded.

Newspapers and magazines

Newspapers can only be read on the library premises. The numerous magazines on offer may be taken out. You can read newspapers from over 100 countries online in the press portal “PressReader”.

Computer and Internet

In the central town library located in K3, you can use computers, laptops, scanners, printers as well as CD players. The use of internet is free of charge. Wi-Fi is available.

Language learning

We offer a wide selection of media to be used for learning foreign languages, whether it be German as a second language, English, French and many others.



Additionally, our offer includes online courses as well as videos for learning, which cover a range of topics, such as computer courses.

Borrowing

Library Card

You will need a library card in order to use the library. You can obtain one by presenting an official photo ID at the information desk.

Children under the age of 14 need to bring the written consent of their parents.

Anyone up the age of 19 can borrow books free of charge. For people aged 19 or older, there is a fee charged for a library card.

Borrowing Fees

You can choose whatever suits your needs among the following rates:

Annual fee: 20 euros

Three-month fee: 8 euros

One-time fee (one item without extensions): 1 euro.

Some of the media have an additional special charge. These -include books on the bestseller lists and TOP DVDs. These items are all marked with the appropriate stickers.
